

DRAGON FIRE™

Dragon Fire High Performance Hull Coat with VS721 is a Super Low Surface Energy coating that reduces drag on the hull by up to 16% at 20 mph. This drag reduction gives competitive sailors



DIRECTIONS:

Surface must be clean, dry and smooth. If necessary, remove marine growth with GREEN GENIE or ALGEX. Remove waterline stain with WATERLINE STAIN REMOVER/ Pred hull with BOAT SCRUB by scrubbing until smooth and shiny. Rinse clean and allow to dry. Apply DRAGON FIRE to all hull surfaces with a damp sponge. Bonding occurs when haze appears. Remove residue haze with a soft dry cloth. Apply 1 2nd coat after 24 hours. Allow to cure for 48 hours before launching boat, Buffing with a soft dry cloth prior to each competition is optional.

MAINTENANCE:

When boat is hauled between competitions, rinse with fresh water to remove salt and dirt. If boat remains moored, dive the boat and wipe off any biofilm with a sponge or Marine Power Mitt prior to competition. Dragon Fire lasts 3 to 6 months, depending on use and sailing conditions; longer in cold fresh water, less in tropical salt water. Re-apply as required to maximize performance benefits.

SIGNIFICANT ADVANTAGES:

Higher Top Speed, Faster Acceleration, Improved Light Air Performance, Faster Tracking and Jibing and Better Downwind Speed. This Super Hydrophobic polymer is more slippery than water and acts as a Fouling Release Coating, reducing attachment of marine growth, salt and dirt, cutting maintenance time and expense and making clean up easier.

Dragon Fire bonds to the hull and lasts up to 6 months in constant water immersion and up to 12 months on dry sailed boats, saving the cost and time of constant re-application. It also provides protection against osmosis blistering and UV damage.

Dragon Fire is easy to apply: Wipe On, Wipe Off. It's suitable for fiberglass, aluminum, stainless steel, bronze and hard painted surfaces. For dry sailed as well as moored boats in salt or fresh water.
